 March 12th from 6:00-7:30 pm.

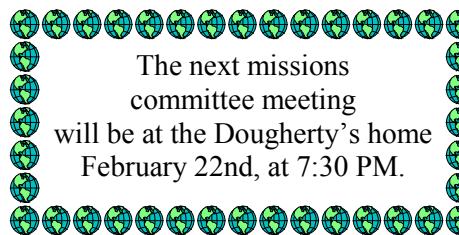
